

**Resolution #2017-16**

**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE SENDING A NEW PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER TO THE POLICE ACADEMY**

**Purpose and Finding:** As the council is aware, over the past year, the Public Safety department has seen staff reductions from retirement and resignations. In order to continue to provide the citizens of Albion with the same level of service that they have become accustomed to, it is necessary to hire additional public safety officers. The City is seeking to hire a new public safety officer who will require police training. As such, it is necessary for them to attend the police academy and become MCOLES certified. The cost of attendance for this officer will be \$7,190.00. Given that this expenditure exceeds \$5,000.00, council approval is required pursuant to Ordinance 2-384.

Council Member French moved, supported by Council Member Lawler, to approve the following resolution.

**RESOLVED**, that the City Council authorizes the expenditure of \$7,190.00 for the Albion Department of Public Safety to send a new officer to the police academy.
