

**CITY OF ALBION  
ORDINANCE 2013-07**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL CHAPTER 64 SECTION 64-23(a)-(c),  
DISSOLVE THE SIGN APPEALS BOARD.**

**Findings and Purpose**

Over time it has proved difficult to populate both the sign appeals board and the zoning board of appeals because of their significant overlap in responsibilities. Furthermore, it is questionable that there is statutory authority for a sign appeals board, standing alone. It is recommended that the sign appeals board be dissolved, ordinances 64-23 (a)-(c) repealed and reserved used for future use. The sign appeals board will be consolidated with the zoning board. It is the intention of the City Council that the provisions this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of Ordinances, City of Albion, Michigan, and the Sections of this Ordinance may be amended to accomplish such intention.

**THE CITY OF ABLION ORDAINS:**

The Sign Appeals Board is hereby dissolved and Ordinance 64-23, subsections (a) through (c) are hereby repealed and reserved for future use.

This Ordinance shall take effect after publication and on May 30, 2013.


