Appointment of Kenneth Snyder as City of Albion Representative to the
Calhoun County Consolidated Dispatch Authority
January 1, 2018 – December 31, 2019

Purpose and Finding: The mission of the Calhoun County Consolidated Dispatch Authority (CCFDA) is to provide the residents and visitors of Calhoun County with a timely and accurate communication link to emergency response services. The CCFDA answers all 9-1-1 and non-emergency calls and efficiently dispatching public safety personnel/agencies within Calhoun County, including the City of Albion

The CCFDA is governed by a Board of Directors, whose membership is comprised of officials appointed from the various municipalities and organizations that the CCFDA services. The nine-member board has the authority to hire an executive director to manage the daily operations of the dispatch center. Previously, the City of Albion appointed Kenneth Snyder as their representative, for the terms that expired on December 31, 2015 and December 31, 2017.

Council Member French moved, supported by Council Member Spicer, to approve the following resolution.

RESOLVED, that the City of Albion hereby re-appoints Kenneth Snyder as City of Albion Representative to the Calhoun County Consolidated Dispatch Authority (CCCSA), for the term of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019.
