**A RESOLUTION FOR REVIEW OF FACILITIES AUTHORIZED BY THE MICHIGAN
REGULATION AND TAXATION OF MARIHUANA ACT**

Findings and Purpose: As the City Council is aware, the council has recently elected to opt out of the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act (MRTMA) as the Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) has not yet developed emergency rules for the operation of those facilities. Council has indicated its desire to revisit the possible licensing of these facilities following the state's adoption of its administrative rules. As such, this resolution provides a directive for the same.

Council Member Williamson moved, supported by Council Member Brown, to approve the following resolution.

RESOLVED, that the Albion City Council shall revisit the issue of whether or not to authorize establishments permitted under the MRTMA to operate within the City of Albion within sixty (60) days of the Michigan Department of Licensing Affairs adoption of its emergency rules for facilities authorized by the MRTMA.


