CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. 2020-35

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE ADMINISTRATION TO PROCEED WITH THE ENGINEERING DESIGN AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESSES FOR THE MILLING AND RESURFACING OF 1ST, 2ND, 3RD, HARTWELL, AND WILD STREETS TOGETHER WITH RELATED WATER SYSTEM AND SIDEWALK UPGRADES.

WHEREAS, on June 4, 2018, the Albion city council expressed its intent to make 1st, 2nd, 3rd, Hartwell, and Wild streets a priority for street improvements for 2020; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020, the city applied for Michigan Transportation Economic Development Fund (MTEDF) Category B grant funding in the amount of \$250,000 to assist in the \$778,000 construction cost of completing these street improvements; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2020, the city council held a study session to discuss funding for these streets; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Finance Director determined that funding is available to complete the resurfacing of these streets, together with related water system and sidewalk upgrades, if the city is awarded MTEDF Category B funding, or to complete some of the streets if no grant funding is awarded; and


WHEREAS, the city council desires to proceed with the completion of these critical street improvement projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albion city council does hereby authorize city administration to proceed with the design engineering and competitive bidding for construction of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, Hartwell, and Wild streets, together with related water system and sidewalk upgrades, at appropriate times to ensure that all of these streets can be improved during the 2021 construction season if the city receives Michigan Transportation Economic Development Fund Category B grant funding, or some of the streets if no grant funding is received.
