

**Resolution #2020-43**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF UP TO \$10,000.00 TO SUPPORT REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE VICTORY PARK TENNIS AND BASKETBALL COURTS**

**WHEREAS**, outdoor programming during the pandemic is one of few options our community has that is safe and low risk and,

**WHEREAS**, the tennis and basketball courts in Victory Park are not in good condition; many racks, faded striping, and poor netting and

**WHEREAS**, Albion's youth and families deserve to have quality athletic facilities in their parks and,

**WHEREAS**, there is ample room in the city and recreation budgets to provide for repair and maintenance of these facilities

**WHEREAS**, these spaces being repaired would provide the opportunity for high-quality youth programming almost immediately for Albion's youth,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Albion City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to provide Council accurate cost and recommendation for repairs along with the expenditure of up to \$10,000.00 for the repairs and maintenance of the Victory Park tennis and basketball courts based on the below estimated from Schweitzer Construction:

Tennis Courts:

- Crack Filling: \$750
- Painting/Striping: \$3,600
- New posts and net systems: \$1,600

Basketball Courts:


- Crack Filling: \$375
- Striping/Painting: \$2,350
- Contingency: \$1,325
