

**CITY OF ALBION
ORDINANCE #2020-07**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE II, TO AMEND SECTION
10-32, MORAL CHARACTER OF APPLICANT

Purpose and Finding:

As the City Council is aware, the City has previously used this broad and somewhat vague section to deny the issuance of mechanical amusement device licenses based upon applicants being in default to the City. Rather than run the risk of a potential legal challenge due to ambiguity as to moral character, the amendment specifies that an applicant may not be in default to the City. Approval is recommended.

THE CITY OF ALBION ORDAINS:

Section 1. Chapter 10, Article II, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Albion, is hereby amended, by amending Section 10-32, as follows:

ARTICLE II: LICENSE

Sec. 10-32. Applicant Requirements

- (a) No license shall be issued pursuant to this chapter to any person who has not attained the age of 18 years.
- (b) No license shall be issued pursuant to this chapter to any person who is in default to the City.
- (c) No license shall be issued pursuant to this chapter for the placement of a mechanical amusement device on the premises of any business establishment that is in default to the City.


Section 2. Severability. This ordinance and each article, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, part, provision, sentence, word and portion thereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if they or any of them are declared to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected.

This Ordinance shall take effect on October 21, 2020 after publication.
