

# How Do I .....

How do I become an Election Inspector?

There can be up to four elections each calendar year. During an election, each unit of government needs a staff of paid workers to work at the polls.

Election Inspectors are people who are paid to assist voters at the polls on Election Day. Anyone Interested in serving as an Election Inspector for the City of Albion must submit an [Election Inspector application](#).

Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years of age
- Must be a registered voter in the State of Michigan
- Cannot be a challenger, candidate, member of candidate's immediate family, or a member of the Local Board of Canvassers.

After your application is accepted, you will need to attend an election training program. This is a training required to become certified as an Election Inspector.
