## **CITY OF ASHLAND**

- MAYOR GILMORE RECORDED A PSA FOR CIRCULATION AS NEEDED
- CENTRAL PARK IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC (SIDEWALK AROUND THE PARK WILL REMAIN OPEN TO ALLOW FRESH AIR WALKING WHILE MAINTAINING SOCIAL DISTANCING)
- THE GENESIS STATUE WAS LIT UP GREEN LAST NIGHT IN HONOR OF FELLOW KENTUCKIANS WHO HAVE PASSED DUE TO COVID19
- THE KDMC/CITY SPONSORED EASTER EGG HUNT IN CENTRAL PARK HAS BEEN CANCELED
- STAFF HAVE DAILY MORNING SKYPE MEETINGS TO ASSESS NEEDS AND PROGRESSES
- RISK MANAGEMENT IS RECORDING A SPREADSHEET OF PPE NEEDS FOR COA
- THE CENTRAL PARK DOG PARK IS CLOSED TO PUBLIC
- THE LIBRARY COMMONS AREA IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC
- THE CITY INDIVIDUAL OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE, NET PROFIT RETURNS FOR 2019 AND PAYMENT OF FEES DUE DATE WILL MOVE TO JULY 15<sup>TH</sup>, 2020 TO ALIGN WITH THE STATE AND FEDERAL TAX FILINGS.

- RECYCLING CENTER REMAINS OPEN TO PUBLIC WITH NORMAL OPERATING HOURS
