Lake County Free Clinic provides a variety of medical and dental services. Our board certified staff and volunteer medical and dental Providers comes from area institutions such as Cleveland Clinic, Lake Health, University Hospitals systems, and local dental offices. We offer general medicine, pediatric medicine, specialty medicine clinics, as well as basic adult and pediatric dental services.

We request that patients make a \$20 donation for office visits. Donations are not required to receive care.
