Dear Dunellen Residents & Business Owners,

Today, I was notified by the Middlesex County Public Health Department that there was one additional confirmed case of COVID-19 in Dunellen, now making the total of one hundred eighty-five in our borough. All cases are under quarantine. Personal information cannot be shared in identifying the persons.

Middlesex County Public Health Department continues to be the lead Agency in all investigations regarding confirmed COVID-19 cases, including all close contacts. If it is determined that a member of the community has been in close contact with any individual who has tested positive for COVID-19, the County will reach out to the individual(s).

Please note that we are aware that the numbers we are reporting for confirmed COVID-19 cases in Dunellen differ from what is being reported on the Middlesex County page. At the same time the County is confirming and reconciling their data, the Borough is also reconciling the data, to produce an accurate count within our borough. The Borough, the County and the State are working hard to release the most accurate and up-to-date information. This situation is fluid and ever-changing, and we appreciate residents' patience as we seek to update the information locally as what we consider most accurate. Furthermore, the State of New Jersey is not releasing recovery data at this time, and therefore, neither is the Middlesex County Public Health Department.

My office will continue to be contact with the Middlesex County Public Health Department and will share whatever information is permitted by law.

The message remains the same, we must maintain social distancing. As seen in our confirmed case numbers, Dunellen has yet to flatten the curve. We must be vigilant in our efforts to ensure the safety and well-being of all of our residents.
