Olson said she had not ran into this situation before and felt they should wait for roll call until they could ask County Attorney Randy Fair about this matter.

Zink presented the Board with the tax roll corrections for Trinity Broadcasting. Anderson moved to authorize the Chairman to sign the tax roll corrections for Trinity Broadcasting as presented, Ervin seconded the motion. Crandall, Krajewski, Ervin, Anderson and Elder voting aye; none voting nay; motion carried.

Fair entered the meeting. Fair stated that on the minutes Board members were just voting on if they correct and it would not matter if they were there or not.
