

# **DRIVER'S SAFETY COURSE ELIGIBILITY**

The State of Texas will allow you to request a dismissal of a **moving traffic charge** upon completion of a driver's safety course once every twelve months. To be eligible to request the dismissal you must meet the following conditions:

**You must be at least 17 years of age at the time of the offense**

**Hold a valid Class C Texas Driver's license (Holders of Commercial Driver's license are NOT eligible) Alleged speed must be less than 25 mph over the speed limit.**

**Not eligible if offense occurred in a construction zone with workers present.**

**Have proof of financial responsibility (liability insurance)**

**Have not completed a driver's safety course to dismiss a charge within the 12 months preceding the date of your current ticket**

If you meet these requirements, you make your request by mail or in person.

Mail your request including your case number to  
Justice of the Peace, Ste.100, 1520 Lake Front Circle, The Woodlands, TX 77380.

Include the following:

**A statement that you are pleading guilty or no contest to the charge**

**A statement that you have not taken a course to dismiss a ticket within the last 12 months**

**A copy of your proof of financial responsibility (insurance)**

**A copy of your Texas Driver's License**

**A copy of your ticket**

**A money order payable to Montgomery County in the amount of \$115.00**

**YOUR REQUEST MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE YOUR APPEARANCE DATE**

You will be sent a receipt, an affidavit which you must sign before a notary and a form for you to request your driving record. You will be given 90 days to complete a course approved by the Texas Education Agency and return the driving certificate (court copy), affidavit and driving record to this office.
