Dear Dog Lover,

The Town of Emmitsburg is building a dog park as an additional amenity to the Community Park. The park will be located west of the tennis courts (see map) and split into two sections: small dogs (35lbs and less) and large dogs (36lbs and more). A double-gated entry on each side will help assure the safety of your pets.

The park will be funded by a grant received from the State of Maryland, but additional money is needed to purchase necessary amenities (i.e. benches, signage, water fountains, trash cans, pick-up bags, and possibly doggy playground equipment). Any donations will help us achieve our goal of providing a quality dog lover facility for our community. Our hope is to raise \$15,000. All donations will be acknowledged on the town website.
