## Reminders:

The watering of lawns, shrubs, flowers, gardens, etc. via the public water system is prohibited every day between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. (per *Town Code 13.04.170*). Anyone violating this section of the code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be subject to a fine of up to two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) or both.

**Hours: Noon to 7:00 p.m., weekends *only* May 26th to June 10th**  
Open 7 days a week from June 11th to September 3, 2018.

\*Proof of residency will be required for all pool users.

\*Only Personal Floatation Devices that are USCGA (United States Coast Guard Approved) will be allowed for use by children.

**Note: Per Town Code, a \$25 fee will be issued to the handler of any animal that deposits feces on any property or area not owned by the person in control of the animal (Section 6.04.140 & 6.04.150).**



## The Dog Park Opens in May 2018!

### Dog Park Rules

1. All dogs must have a valid Frederick County or out of district license and current rabies tag in order to use the Town of Emmitsburg dog park.
2. The park is designed to allow larger dogs on one side, and smaller dogs on the other.
3. No female dogs in heat.
4. No dogs under four months of age.
5. Handler may have no more than two dogs at one time.
6. All handlers must be 16 years old or older.
7. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years old or older.
8. Dogs shall be removed at the first sign of aggression. Aggressive dogs shall not be permitted within the park. An "aggressive dog" is defined as a dog(s) posing a threat to human beings or other animals. Handlers are legally responsible for their dog(s) and any injury caused by them.
9. Owner / Handler shall carry a leash at all times. Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the park.
10. Owner / Handler must clean up after their dog(s).
11. No food, no smoking, no glass containers.
12. No professional dog training or grooming.
13. Owner / Handler must remain inside gate within view of dog(s) at all times.
14. Owner / Handler must fill in holes created by their dog(s).
15. Excessive barking will not be tolerated. Persistent barking will require dog(s) to be removed from the premises.

**Dog Park Hours: 6:00 a.m. to one-half hour after sunset**

# Park Pavilion Reservations



Emmitsburg has one park pavilion in Community Park and one in Memorial Park available for public use. Reservation includes use of facilities, bathrooms and utilities. Both pavilions feature a grill and picnic tables. Payment and a reservation form must be completed to use the premise.

**Cost: \$75 for Emmitsburg residents** (verified by State ID) , **\$125 for non-residents**. \$25 refundable if park and bathrooms are left in good condition and all trash bags are placed in proper receptacles.



## To reserve a pavilion please do the following:

1. Check availability by contacting the town office at (301) 600– 6300 or [info@emmitsburgmd.gov](mailto:info@emmitsburgmd.gov).
2. Fill out a park pavilion reservation request form. The form can be found on the town website or can be provided at the town office.
3. Submit the form and reservation fee (in cash, check or credit card) to the town office by mail or in person.
4. Pick-up park keys in town office between 8:00 and 4:30 p.m. the business day before your reservation.

## Environmental Tips

To prevent blockages and/or sewer overflows in your home and the town sewer system, please refrain from dumping the following items down your toilet, drain or garbage disposal:

- Fats, oils or grease from cooking, cars or lawnmowers
- Coffee grinds
- Egg shells
- Produce stickers
- Chunks of garbage
- Disposable diapers
- Feminine hygiene products
- Paper towels of any kind
- Cloth mop strands
- Flushable cat litter
- Rags
- Condoms
- Bags/wrapping and cardboard
- Solvents, paints, turpentine, nail polish, nail polish remover
- Flammable or explosive substances
- Corrosive substances that are either acidic or caustic
- Needles and sharps
- Prescription and/or over the counter medication
